## **SC & MT Water Conservation & Quality Guidelines**

### **GOALS:**

- 1. Reduce water use by 10% by 2015
- 2. Save Money
- 3. Reduce Water Pollution
- 4. Support water conservation

# FACILITY OPERATIONS & ENGINEERING

A faucet dripping every 6 seconds wastes approximately 550 gallons of water a year.

- Perform preventative maintenance on all boilers, condensers, pipes and water mains
- Install lavatory faucets meeting EPA WaterSense specifications ( 1.5 gpm)
- Install waterless urinals
- Install low-flow toilets meeting EPA EPA WaterSense specifications (1.3 gpf or dual flush)
- Install showers meeting EPA WaterSense specifications ( 2.0 gpm)

- Adopt smart meter technology as it becomes available
- Where available, use non-potable water for irrigation and fire emergency
- Purchase low flow equipment such as power washers and washing machines
- Implement natural landscaping methods where possible and plant native species that don't require a lot of water
- Use drip irrigation systems
- Irrigate grass and landscaping in the evening when it is cool

#### FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- Plan ahead when you thaw food; put items in the fridge in advance rather than thawing under warm running water
- Fill dishwashers to capacity
- Report leaks, improperly working equipment, and opportunities to conserve water to engineering

### Did you know?

There are 185 waterless urinals in STAPLES Center and 91 in Microsoft Theater which conserve 750,000 gallons of water per year.
